New USCG Port Security Advisory (PSA) 1-17

Conditions of Entry – Vessels arriving from Nauru

The U.S. Coast Guard has issued a new **Port Security Advisory (PSA) 1-17** (copy attached) on the imposition of Conditions of Entry on vessels arriving from ports/countries that do not maintain effective anti-terrorism measures. An updated list of such ports/countries is included in paragraph B of the attached Advisory. The nation of Nauru has been included, after the Coast Guard determined that Nauru is not maintaining effective anti-terrorism measures in all of its ports.

All vessels arriving at the United States that previously visited the countries listed in paragraph B of the Advisory (with exceptions as noted) during their last five port calls must take actions 1 through 5 listed in paragraph C of the Advisory, while in the countries listed in paragraph B, as a condition of future entry into U.S. ports.

NOTE : PSA 1-17 supersedes all previous Advisories on this subject, which should be disregarded.
