U.S. IMPOSES NEW SANCTIONS AGAINST IRAN: EFFECT ON SHIPPING SHOULD BE MINIMAL

February 6, 2017

Introduction

On February 3, 2017, in response to a ballistic missile test reportedly conducted by Iran on January 29, the U.S. Office of Foreign Asset Control ("OFAC") sanctioned 25 individuals and entities either involved in Iran's missile program or in a network supporting terrorist activities in Lebanon. All of the individuals and entities are now named to the U.S. Specially Designated Nationals ("SDN") List.

Effect on Shipping Should be Minimal

Since these latest sanctions target specific individuals and entities, and not products or sectors of the Iranian economy, the overall effect on international shipping should be minimal. None of the secondary sanctions lifted on January 16, 2016 under the Joint comprehensive Plan of Action have been re-imposed.
